

Article IV: Fines

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the fines?

- Missed Meetings: Notification must be provided to the Secretary and or Vice President
 - 1st missed meeting without notice = NO FINE
 - Any additional missed meeting after the 1st one without notice = \$10.00 fine
- Missed Assignment: Notification must be provided to the Commissioner and or UIC
 - Notified outside of 24 hours of game time = NO FINE
 - Notified inside of 24 hours of game time and game is covered = NO FINE unless identified as a trend for the individual, if this is determined is made a fine of \$10.00 will be assessed
 - Notified within 24 hours and game is not covered = Fine of game fee
- Late arrivals
 - 1st and 2nd offense = NO FINE
 - 3rd and subsequent offenses = FINE of 25% of game fee
- Uniform Violations
 - 1st Offense – NO FINE (WARNING)
 - 2nd and subsequent offenses = FINE of \$10.00
- EJECTIONS
 - ALL EJECTIONS must be reported to the UIC within 24 hours, leave a phone message AND send an email explaining the situation and your position. A FINE of \$10.00 will be assessed if you do not report the ejection to the UIC within 24 hours.
- What if I know in advance that I am going to miss a meeting?
 - Contact the Secretary and Vice President by email and let them both know the reason their contact information is jdefranco@cox.net or VASportsnuts@yahoo.com
- If you missed attending a meeting/ Contact the Secretary and Vice President as in above paragraph, if excused then NO FINE if unexcused then fines as listed above.
- How will I be charged the fine?
 - Fines will be deducted from your next check.
- How do I appeal a fine?
 - Email a written appeal to the Vice President at VASportnuts@yahoo.com a decision will be made, if dissatisfied with the decision of the VP you can
 - Appeal to the Disciplinary Committee by informing the VP as listed above (VP and 2 of the 3 members at large), will meet and review, a decision will be made within 30 days, if still dissatisfied you can
 - Appeal to the Board of Director's (BOD) by sending a written request to the President, a decision will be made by the board within 30 days, if still dissatisfied with decision can then
 - Appeal to the General Membership, once they have heard the appeal and ruled, at the next available General membership meeting, and that decision will be final.
