

Bob Angeli is the President of the Northern Virginia Softball Umpires Association. He was born and raised in Philadelphia, Pa and enlisted in the Air Force after graduation from High School. He retired from the Air Force in 2009 after serving 27 years with assignments in Colorado, Germany, Texas, Florida, Korea and Washington DC, plus deployments to Egypt and Uzbekistan.

He began his umpiring career in 1992 in Ft Walton Beach, FL as a slow pitch umpire. In 1993, after a class action lawsuit all FL High Schools were mandated to switch their girls softball program from slow pitch to fast pitch and was not grand-fathered so all umpires completed fast pitch umpire training at the neighboring University of West Florida in Pensacola.

He umpired High School softball in Florida, Texas and Virginia as well as the NCAA sanctioned Rebel Spring Games in Florida for 18 years. He has worked several PONY National Tournament, State AA HS Championship, several ASA state tournaments and 7 ASA National Tournaments to include the ASA/USA 18U and ASA/USA 16U National Tournaments.

He previously served as Vice President and a Member at Large of the Association. He was elected President in 2012.
